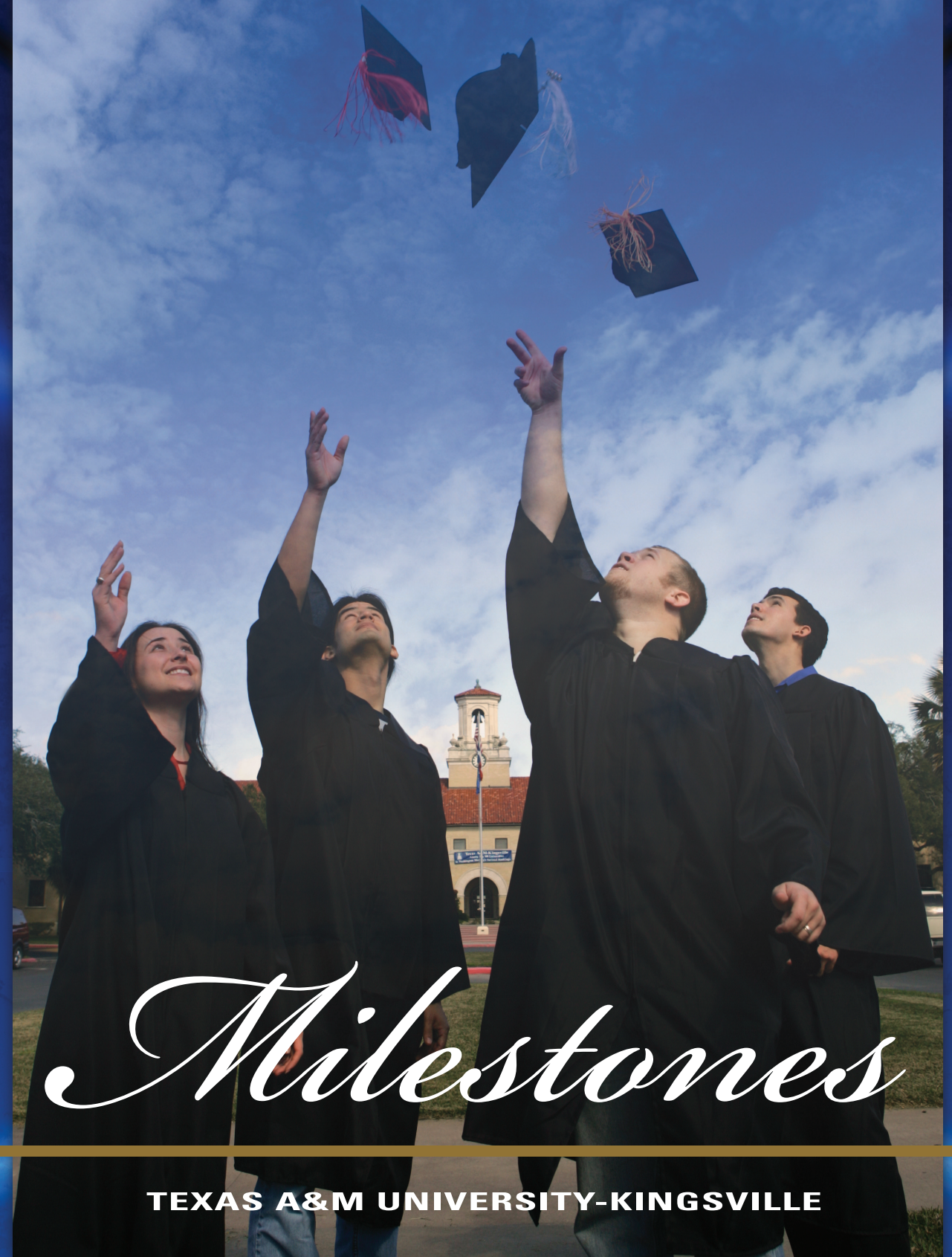

College Spotlight

College of Agriculture, Natural Resources & Human Sciences

A new name for the college came early in 2006. The Texas A&M University System Board of Regents and the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board authorized the university to add "natural resources" to the name of the college, now called the College of Agriculture, Natural Resources and Human Sciences. The name change reflects the fact that the scope of the college has changed over the past decade to today where 40 percent of the faculty identify themselves as having a wildlife or range management specialty. The college had several other "firsts" in 2006. Aaron Haines achieved two of those "firsts" as he received the first independent Doctor of Philosophy degree in wildlife science since the college converted from the joint program and in so doing, he became the first graduate to receive an independent Ph.D. in the history of the university. When the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board gave A&M-Kingsville final approval to create a master of science degree in ranch management, it granted the King Ranch Institute for Ranch Management another first...the distinction of having the only degree of its kind in the world. The new degree took effect Jan. 1, 2007 with the first two students scheduled to graduate in August. In June, Gov. Rick Perry signed a bill authorizing tuition revenue bonds for public higher education institutions across the state. One part of the bill provides for \$9.5 million for a new Citrus Center for Texas A&M University-Kingsville. The current Citrus Center, located in Weslaco, is housed in World War II-vintage barracks that were converted over 60 years ago to meet the scientific research and educational needs of the citrus industry in the Rio Grande Valley. Ground-breaking for the new center is scheduled for 2007. At the Stephen J. "Tio" and Janell Kleberg Wildlife Research Park, work was started on the flight cage at the Duane M. Leach Research Aviary, also scheduled for completion in 2007. Funding also was secured for the Albert and Margaret Alkek Ungulate Research Facility at the research park.



College of Arts & Sciences

Awards, accolades and accomplishments could be found throughout the College of Arts and Sciences in 2006. External funding for the college totaled \$2.51 million for 2006. Approval was given to create the new bachelor of science in biomedical sciences degree program in 2006. The degree is part of the newly named department of biological and health sciences, a merging of the departments of biology and communication sciences and disorders. The chemistry department was awarded its ninth straight Welch Foundation Departmental Grant, a grant available by invitation only to small and medium-

sized Texas educational institutions. College Physics I/College Physics II, taught by Dr. Dan Suson, was named among the top physics courses in the nation by the College Board. Regents Professor and director of the Natural Toxins Research Center Dr. John C. Pérez was selected by *Hispanic Engineer & Information Technology* magazine as one of the 100 Most Important Hispanics in Technology and Business for the second year in a row. College departments welcomed a number of special guests to campus, including Fulbright Scholar-in-Residence for spring 2006 Dr. John Minns of the University



of New South Wales, award-winning filmmaker Ray Santisteban and master printer Ernest de Soto. Student accomplishments in the college included the local chapter of the Student Affiliates of the American Chemical Society (ACS) being recognized nationally for the 11th year in a row on the ACS award listing of outstanding, commendable and honorable mention student chapters. Students in music competed at the National Trumpet Competitions, the International Tuba Euphonium Association Conference and were among a handful of university wind symphonies to perform at the renowned Texas Music Educators Association Convention.



College of Business Administration

The College of Business Administration earned both faculty and student accolades in 2006. Dr. George G. Gresham, assistant professor of marketing and management, received the Students' Choice Distinguished Teaching Excellence Award for the year. Two student organizations were able to attend national professional meetings. Six members of the American Marketing Association attended the group's 28th annual International Collegiate Conference in Orlando, Florida. Over 1,000 marketing students got together for three days for career and leadership training and networking. A total of 16 student members of the Accounting Society attended the Institute of Management Accountants Sixth Annual Student Leadership Conference, also in Orlando. Student sessions focused on getting started on a career in professional accounting and continuing to develop that career.





College of Education

The College of Education earned the State Board for Educator Certification's rating of "accredited" once again, based on the performance of A&M-Kingsville candidates taking the exam to become certified Texas educators. It's a distinction the college has held for more than 25 years, without interruption or being placed on probationary status or under review during that time. Associate professor Dr. Roberto L. Torres joined the ranks of the U.S. government's flagship program in international educational exchange, the Fulbright Scholar Program. Torres went to the Universidad Autonoma de Nuevo Leon in Monterrey, Mexico, for scholarly work in the College of Psychology during the fall 2006 and spring 2007 semesters. Dr. Gary Low, professor for educational leadership and counseling at A&M-Kingsville, was co-presenter of the Best Institute at the 2005 College Academic Support Programs state conference in College Station. The year concluded with Dr. Nestor Sherman being named as Texas Association for Health, Physical Education, Recreation and Dance 2007 Scholar, based on his state and national scholarly activity, training experience and recommendations of his peers. Nineteen doctoral degrees in bilingual education and 14 in education leadership would be awarded by the college in 2006.

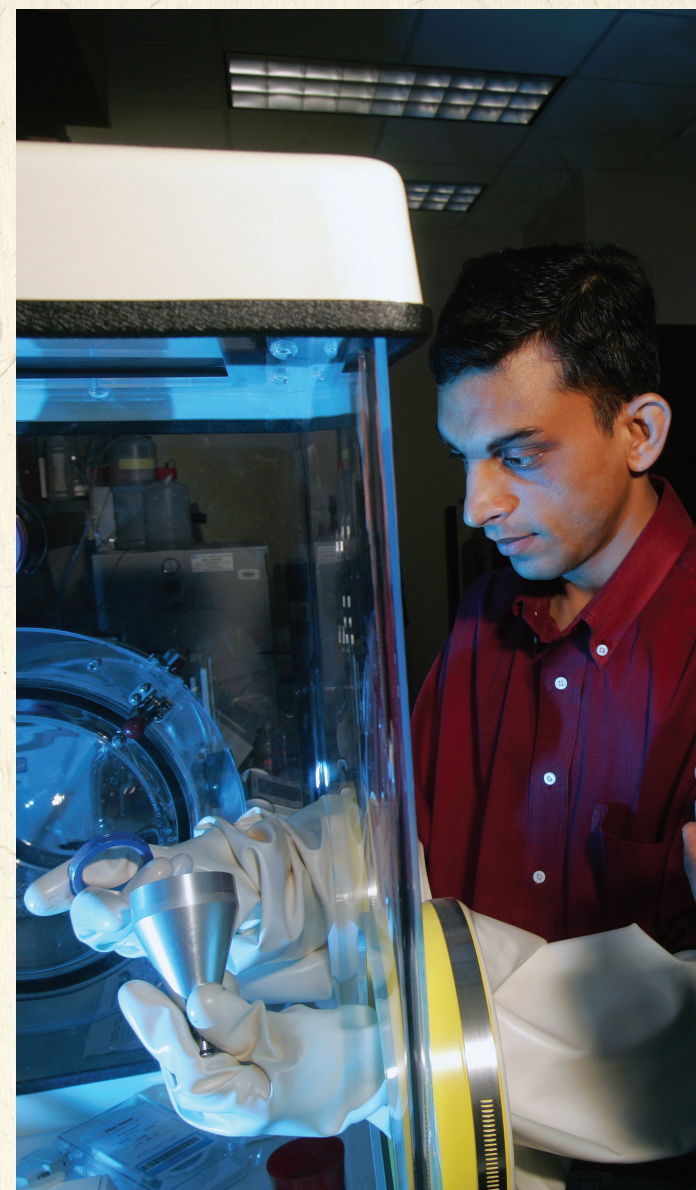


Frank H. Dotterweich College of Engineering

The key word was progress for both new and established programs in the Frank H. Dotterweich College of Engineering. Research funding from federal, state and private sources totaled \$1.9 million for the College in 2006. Among that funding was a Major Research Instrumentation award from the National Science Foundation (NSF) for the purchase of a high performance computing cluster to be used across disciplines. The Center of Research Excellence in Science and Technology-Research on Environmental Sustainability of Semi-Arid Coastal Areas, or CREST-RESSACA, started its fifth year of

NSF funding. At this point, CREST-RESSACA has supported 80 students, of whom 32 have graduated. The new architectural engineering bachelor's program finished its first year with more than 20 students enrolled, while the first cohort of three Ph.D.s in environmental engineering graduated. For the third year in a row, the student chapter of the American Society of Civil Engineers (ASCE) qualified for national competition in the ASCE/American Institute of Steel Construction Inc. Steel Bridge Competition. The College

addressed future students as well in 2006, as evident in earning an NSF Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics Talent Expansion Program grant worth \$1 million to facilitate the recruitment and retention of community college students over a five-year period. Through this grant came the "May-Mester" program, which provided a two-week research experience for 20 community college students. Finally, the College hosted, managed and provided funding for the Boosting Engineering, Science and Technology robotics competition, which brought students from 15 regional high schools to the campus.



College of Graduate Studies

The College of Graduate Studies spearheaded participation of students in the Fourth Annual Texas A&M University System Pathways Student Research Symposium, hosted by Prairie View A&M in November 2006. Dean Alberto Olivares and the McNair Scholars Program staff accompanied 60 students to present their research, with four of them ranking among the award winners. Fall 2006 showed a 4 percent increase in master's enrollment compared to 2005. The year also saw the appointment of Olivares to the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board's Graduate Education Advisory Committee. Finally, 50 graduate scholarships and thirty doctoral assistantships totaling \$440,000 were awarded to outstanding newly recruited and continuing graduate students.

Texas A&M University-Kingsville System Center-San Antonio

Officials with The Texas A&M University System and the Texas A&M University-Kingsville System Center-San Antonio worked out an agreement with South San Antonio Independent School District to lease a former elementary school. The center, currently located in portable buildings adjacent to Palo Alto College, has outgrown its current space. Some classes were moved in February 2007 and the remainder of the System Center facilities will be in place in the new location in time for the fall 2007 semester. The System Center, along with the Southwest Independent School District (SWISD) was one of only 10 collaborations around the country chosen for the Toyota Family Literacy Grant. The SWISD receives the grant and System Center faculty, staff and students volunteer to help implement the literacy program.



University College

University College serves as the home for academic programs for incoming students during their first year in college. In 2006, A&M-Kingsville was selected as a member of the 2005-2006 National Select Cohort inaugural class for the Foundations of Excellence® in the First College Year. As one of only 13 four-year institutions selected for this project, A&M-Kingsville participated in national conferences and collaborated

with other four-year campuses on this project. Dr. Dann Brown, dean of University College, received the Past-President's Award from the New Mexico Higher Education Assessment Association, and Betty Black, developmental reading and supplemental instruction coordinator, was elected president-elect of the Texas Association of Developmental Education.



Division of Student Affairs

In an effort to provide students a larger variety of choices at mealtimes, Pizza Hut was relocated to the Javelina Café and in its place, Starbucks opened with a full line of coffee drinks. Recreational sports will get a new home after The Texas A&M Board of Regents approved the construction of a new Recreational Sports Complex, set for completion in 2008. The Community Service Component got under way in the fall 2006 with students completing hundreds of hours of community service including volunteering for Habitat for Humanity, Keep Kingsville Clean, and other projects. In 2006, Seferino "Nino" Mendietta, was named director of the Memorial Student Union Building and student activities, and he led by example in his appointment as regional coordinator of the National Association for Campus Activities Central Region. Karen Engebrecht, career services director, was selected by the U.S. Department of the Interior to serve on a task force geared to enhance employment options for students. Several projects in the residence halls also were completed in 2006. A fire suppression system was installed in Lewis Hall and new stoves and water heaters were installed in the Student Family Apartments. For the safety of the residence hall students, lighting around the halls and parking lots was improved. The Peer Educator Program – which works to increase students' awareness on various social issues – earned honors as the Program of the Year and Outstanding Student Organization. One its members, Amanda Pena, an engineering major, was named Outstanding Peer Educator for the Texas, New Mexico, Oklahoma and Louisiana region. Outreach to future students also got a boost in 2006, as Special Programs received four-year funding for a new program, Educational Talent Search, that targets six area high schools and two middle schools.



Texas A&M Health Science Center Irma Lerma Rangel College of Pharmacy

The dream became a reality in 2006 as the 78-member inaugural class of the Irma Lerma Rangel College of Pharmacy enrolled and began classes. In March, management of the college was transferred to the Texas A&M Health Science Center, a move that stabilized its funding and enabled the college to take part in the HSC's existing clinical, research and training affiliations. A series of grand opening events took place in August as students reported for

classes, culminating in a ribbon-cutting ceremony attended by some 400 people. As the semester progressed, some students – not yet accustomed to the rigorous curriculum of a professional school – began experiencing difficulties with their coursework. Dean Indra Reddy and the pharmacy college faculty immediately went to work, developing study skills and tutoring sessions that enabled all students to succeed in their first semes-

ter. The class lost just two students – both for personal reasons and not due to poor academic performance. The class hosted its first public health fair in December, featuring demonstrations and lectures on a variety of health topics. The college's success in its first semester, however, is best phrased by student Brian McCarty of Nacogdoches: "It's better than I thought it would be. I love it, it's challenging, and the facilities are awesome. Dean Reddy is very student-centered. He gets students excited."

Making an Impact

Capital Campaign Success

Texas A&M University-Kingsville advanced its first-ever capital campaign in 2006 with great success. The three-year Building On Our Traditions Campaign, co-chaired by Tio and Janell Kleberg with honorary chair Mary Lewis Kleberg, is on track to raise \$10 million to support student scholarships and research opportunities at A&M-Kingsville. In just the first 20 months of the campaign, our alumni and other friends have provided us with 85 percent of our goal.

By year's end, \$8.45 million in gifts and pledges was received from a variety of donors who want to support the university. Most of this effort has gone to strengthen our most crucial endeavor – our scholarship endowment. By year's end, \$5.2 million or 63 percent raised to-date was earmarked for scholarships. Donors also have seen the need to increase the university's capacity for research and other academic support; in 2006, 21 percent or \$1.7 million of the campaign donations were earmarked for these purposes.

A key to our success is the work of the Texas A&M University-Kingsville Foundation. This independent, private, non-profit corporation exists for the sole purpose of sup-

porting the university, providing an average of more than \$1 million annually in support to the university through earnings from more than 75 endowments.

With its endorsement of the Building on Our Traditions Capital Campaign, the Texas A&M-Kingsville Foundation serves as the preferred recipient for campaign gifts, where its excellent record of stewardship assures donors that their gifts are received, recorded, invested and maintained with the greatest care and highest standards. Individual members of the foundation's Board of Trustees also have made personal pledges to the campaign, leading by example in helping the university grow and become even more viable to the people of the South Texas region.

Others are leading by example as well; just one example of how people are continuing to respond to our historic campaign started with one alumnus, expanded to a company, led to another alumnus, and then grew to include that company's employees and vendors.

Texas A&I alumnus Wayne King, who is a great friend of his alma mater and retired from Valero Refining, encouraged Valero to donate to the campaign. Valero then



partnered with another alumnus and employee, George Kain. The result was the creation of the Valero-George Kain Endowed Scholarship Fund in Engineering.

Valero employees – who hold both Wayne and George in high regard – then supported the scholarship fund. They told their contractors and other suppliers about it, who also contributed to the fund.

The end result? Today, we have gifts and pledges totaling \$570,000 dedicated for deserving students in engineering.

While a corporation, alumni and other friends joined together in making the Valero-George Kain Endowed Scholarship Fund in Engineering a reality, a single foundation continues to make a difference in our agriculture program.

The Robert J. and Helen C. Kleberg Foundation provided a three-year, \$825,000 gift to the campaign to support two programs in the College of Agriculture, Natural Resources and Human Sciences, both coordinated by the world renowned Caesar Kleberg Wildlife Research Institute.

In 2006, \$125,000 of the gift was granted to the South Texas Natives program. The program develops native plants for

restoration by producing commercially and economically viable native seeds and plant materials and by developing strategies for reclamation.

The project is particularly beneficial to South Texas because the area's economy is largely tied to its natural resources, and its native plant species are extremely diverse. Native plants contribute to the stability and resilience of the region, so the efforts of the South Texas Natives program are essential to maintain the region's ecosystems and natural resources. The Robert J. and Helen C. Kleberg Foundation was a founding sponsor for the South Texas Natives program, which will release its first native plant material to the commercial market in 2007.

South Texas migratory birds also benefited from the Robert J. and Helen C. Kleberg Foundation in 2006. The Migratory Bird Program received \$150,000 of the foundation's total gift to fund research that will ultimately benefit those who manage and develop land in making decisions regarding migratory bird populations.

These decisions will become increasingly more important as development continues on the lower Texas coast. Understanding how birds use the landscape, specific habitats and the airspace above the region will provide needed information to help guide placement of development projects to minimize impacts on migratory birds.

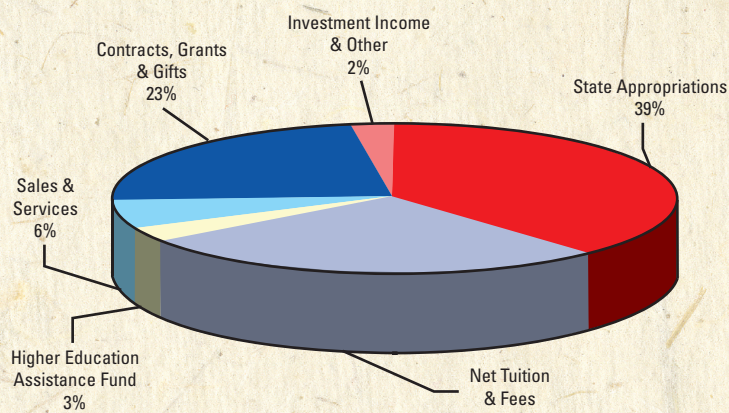
The support of the foundation enables these programs to continue their growth and success and create a lasting impact on the diverse habitats and species that are native to our region.

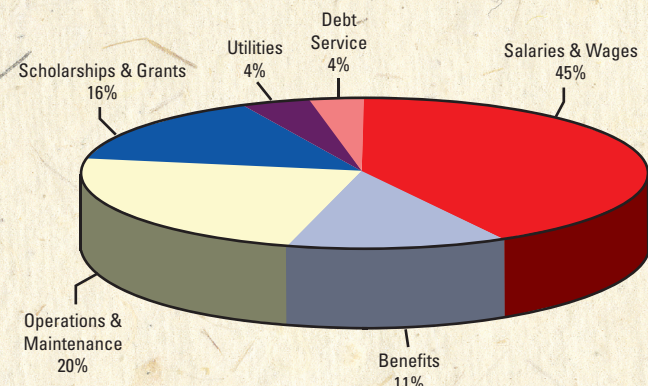
By the Numbers

Budgeted Revenue: \$110.8 million

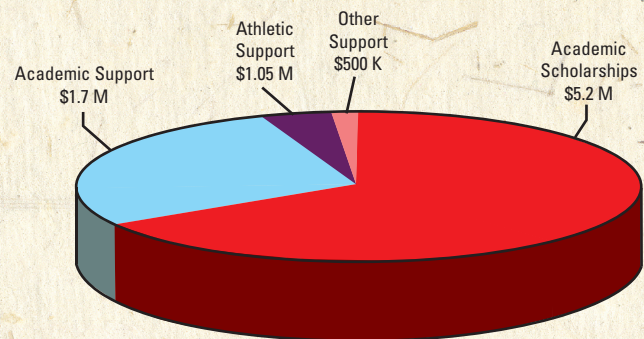


Budgeted Expenses: \$109.7 million

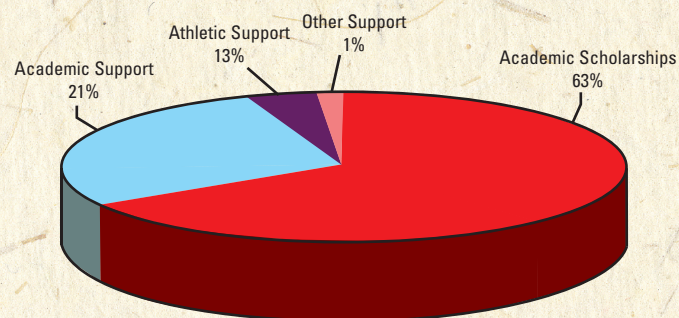


2006 Building on Our Traditions Campaign

Two new coaches take leadership roles at Texas A&M-Kingsville

The direction of two Javelina athletic programs changed in late 2006 when Keith Baxter was named head football coach and Shannon Pierson was promoted to head volleyball coach.

Baxter brings with him a philosophy on football and life that resonates with Super Bowl coaches Lovie Smith of the Chicago Bears and Tony Dungy of the Indianapolis Colts. All three coaches believe in winning with class and dignity. Those who mistake Baxter's soft-spoken demeanor for weakness will find that he is a determined leader. "What impresses me about him is how he carries himself," says sophomore Mike Martinez. "He's very confident in what he says and he believes in his system and that we will be successful."

Those leadership skills have already paid dividends with the renewed spirit and commitment of the current Javelina football team and with the future Javelinas that are set to join the program for 2007.

While Baxter is new to Javelina Athletics, Pierson is not. She was an assistant volleyball coach at A&M-Kingsville for the past three seasons and has been instrumental in bringing successful student-athletes to campus. Now she gets her chance to use her past experiences as a player to lead the Javelina volleyball program. "I've seen a lot of different approaches to the game as both a coach and a player," says Pierson. "I played on successful teams in junior college and in Division I. It's just a matter of incorporating those philosophies into one."

Her credentials as a player are impeccable and she had the opportunity to learn from some of the best coaches in the country. During her two seasons at Barton County Community College, the Cougars posted a 121-7 overall record, finishing third and fourth at the NJCAA National Tournament. Pierson played for a pair of coaches that are now head coaches in the Big XII Conference – Ray Bechard (Kansas) and Suzie Fritz (Kansas State).

She then had two successful seasons at the University of Arkansas-Little Rock, helping the Trojans to consecutive Sun Belt Conference championships and a trip to the NCAA Regional Tournament in 1998. While at UALR she played for Van Compton who led UALR to four NCAA Division I Tournament appearances.

With the ascension of Baxter and Pierson, fall seasons in Kingsville should be fun.

Texas A&M University-Kingsville continues to lead South Texas in research.

As the only institution south of San Antonio classified as a Doctoral/Research University by the Carnegie Foundation for the Advancement of Teaching, Texas A&M-Kingsville conducts more sponsored research than any other university in South Texas. The university also ranks 12th in the state in research expenditures and second to Texas A&M University in College Station among Texas A&M System institutions.

The importance of the research activity conducted at Texas A&M-Kingsville can be seen in its potential to move South Texas forward. For example, one of the university's premiere research centers, the Caesar Kleberg Wildlife Research Institute, directed by Dr. Fred Bryant, celebrated its 25th anniversary in 2006. It is the leading wildlife research organization in Texas and one of the finest in the nation. Its mission is to provide science-based information for enhancing the conservation and management of wildlife in South Texas and related environments. Institute scientists focus on five broad areas of research: Wildlife Biology, Ecology, and Management; Habitat Ecology and Management; Wildlife Diseases, Parasitology, and Toxicology; Economic Development of Natural Resources; and Citizen Science.

The Caesar Kleberg Wildlife Research Institute was established in 1981 by a grant from the Caesar Kleberg Foundation for Wildlife Conservation and has grown into one of the leading wildlife research programs in the United States, with continued funding from private, state and federal sources. Federal grants also support the work of several other stellar researchers, such as Dr. Jianhong Ren in the environmental engineering department, who has a multi-year National Science Foundation grant that supports research on the "Effects of Particle Aggregation/Disaggregation and Precipitation on Sediment and Contaminant Transport in River Systems." This program links Ren's work with student

engagement in the research of transport processes in natural streams and in developing models for the assessment of contaminated streams and remediation schemes. Supplemental funds have been made available by NSF for both graduate and undergraduate students to engage in the research, with integration of this research into the engineering curriculum also as a goal of this project.

Also in the environmental engineering department, Dr. Alvaro Martinez's project on "Pollution Prevention Approach to Reduce Emission" was funded by the Environmental Protection Agency under the Border 2012 Initiative that focuses on environmental issues along the Texas-Mexico border. Graduate students in the engineering Ph.D. program were involved in the research along with collaborators in Mexico.

Dr. Michelle Garcia in the animal and wildlife science department has funding from both the National Institutes of Health and from the U.S. Department of Agriculture for research on leptin, a hormone involved in pubertal development. Her work in 2006 has led to additional National Institutes of Health funding for 2007 and 2008.

Dr. Tom McGehee in the physics and geosciences department is conducting ongoing research with the Army Corps of Engineers. His research on "Modeling for Groundwater Contamination" is one phase of this collaboration. McGehee includes graduate and undergraduate students in this research thereby enhancing students' learning experiences outside of the classroom.

Dr. John Pérez directs the work of the Natural Toxins Research



Center, the only federally funded viper research center in the United States and one of the leading research centers in the world for discovering toxins that can be used in biomedical research. Its computer-controlled serpentarium houses 450 venomous snakes from 24 different species. It is one of the world's leading research centers for the discovery of medically important toxins found in snake venom. The Natural Toxins Research Center is involved in research that may one day give us clues to preventing and treating heart attack, stroke, cancer and other life-threatening conditions.

Research is, as Zora Neale Hurston wrote, formalized curiosity, an intentional and focused quest to know more. Faculty researchers at Texas A&M-Kingsville are intent and focused on advancing the body of knowledge for the benefit of our region, state and nation.

Our Excellence is Recognized

National Rankings

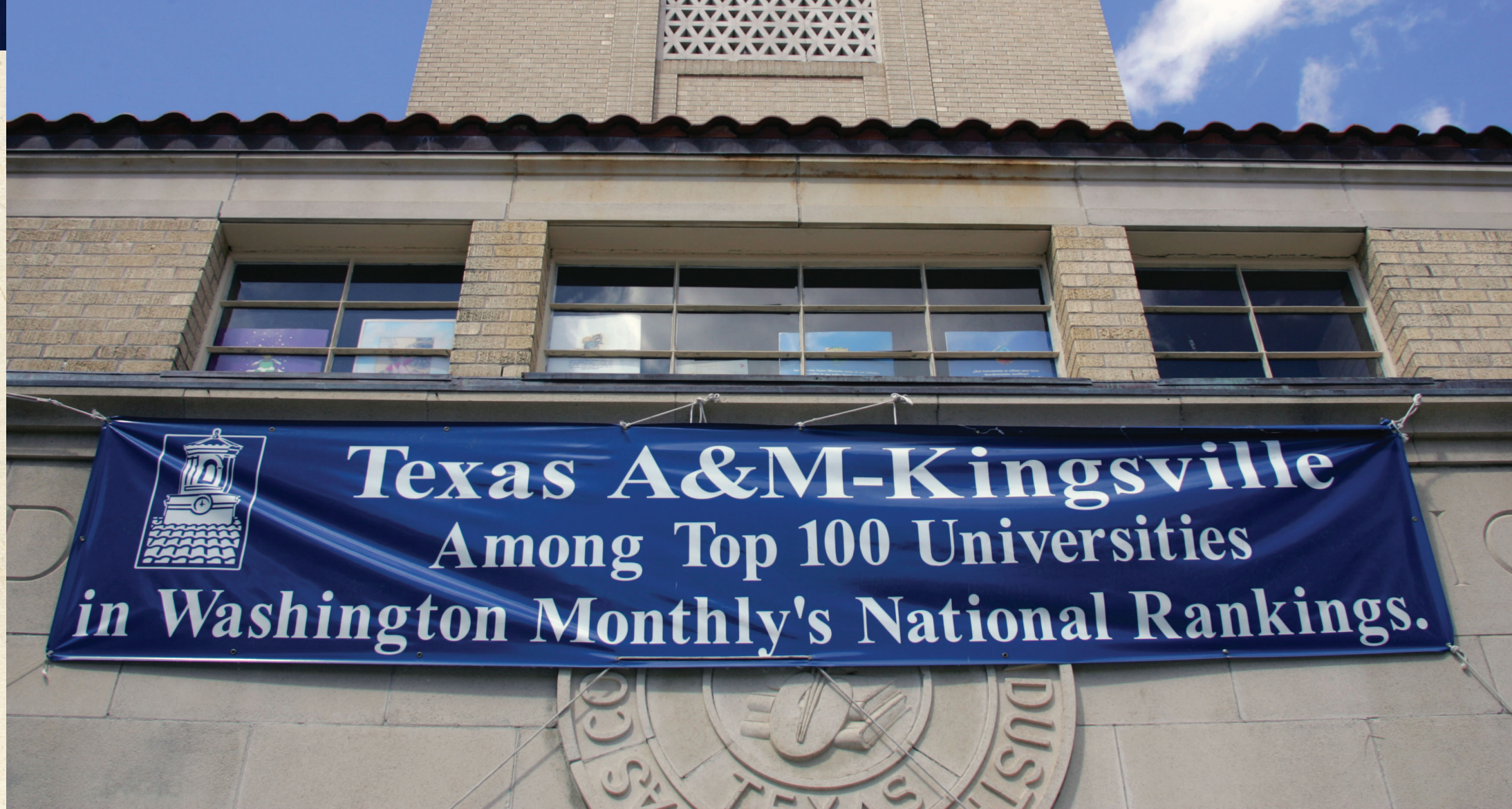
Texas A&M-Kingsville's success earned the university several national accolades in 2006, reaffirming the university's position as an institution that makes a real difference in improving the lives of its students, community and the nation.

The September 2006 issue of *Washington Monthly* magazine featured its second annual national college rankings, and among the top 100 was Texas A&M-Kingsville. The university ranked 77th and was one of only four Texas universities among the top 100 of the magazine's ranking of 245 institutions on its "National Universities" list. The others were Texas A&M University (5th), the University of Texas at Austin (17th) and Rice University (26th).

The magazine sought to develop a different set of criteria to rank universities than those of other magazines and college guides. *Washington Monthly's* rankings are centered around three indicators of a school's benefit to the nation: how well a school performs as an engine of social mobility; how well it does in fostering scientific and humanistic research; and how well it promotes an ethic of service to country.

Also in September, Texas A&M-Kingsville and The Ohio State University were named National Role Model Institutions by Minority Access Inc., a national non-profit educational organization. Dr. Jamie Laurenz, associate vice president for academic affairs, and Liza Soliz, a two-time graduate of A&M-Kingsville, also were honored by the group.

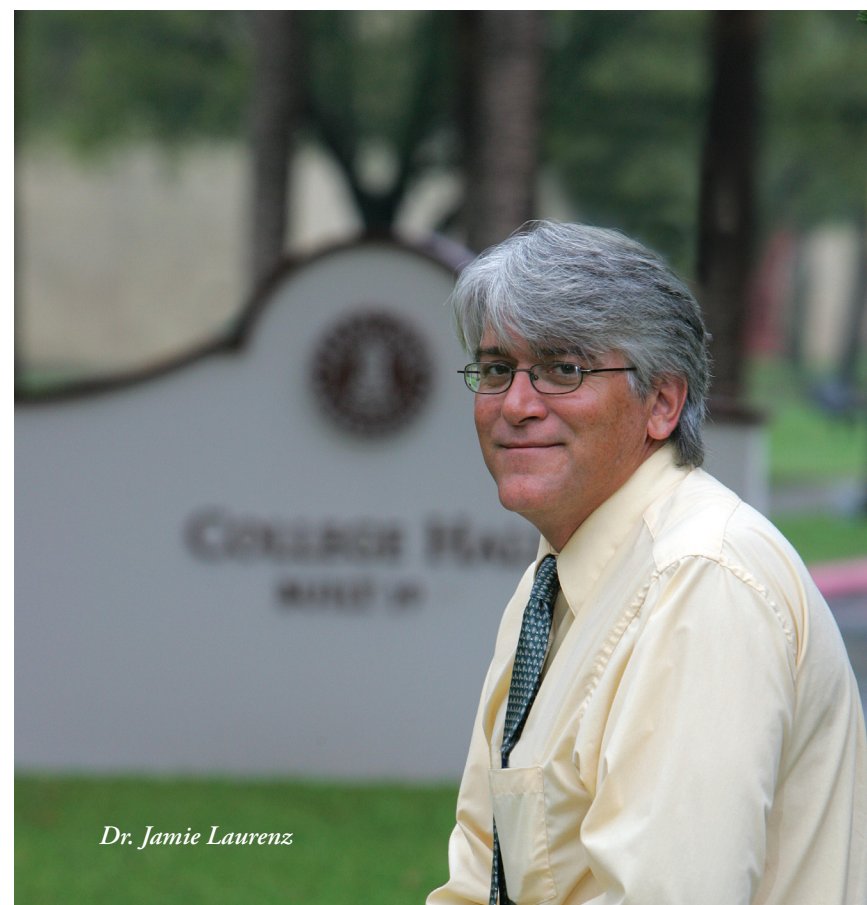
The National Role Model Institution award is presented annually to universities that demonstrate a campus-wide commitment to diversity. The Role Model Initiative is a cooperative agreement between the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services and Minority Access Inc. to identify institutional and individual role models produc-



ing or supporting minority researchers, particularly in the biomedical sciences. The research of Laurenz and Soliz centers around the immune system and stress physiology in animals. Laurenz served as faculty mentor to Soliz, who earned her bachelor of science degree in biology and her master's degree in animal science at A&M-Kingsville in 2006 and is currently working on her Ph.D. in animal science at Texas A&M University in College Station.

The university continued its strong showing in *Hispanic Outlook* magazine's annual rankings, released in May 2006. Using the latest data from the National Center for Educational Statistics, the magazine issued the Top 100 Institutions for Hispanics based on bachelor's, master's and doctoral degrees awarded.

Texas A&M-Kingsville ranked fourth in agriculture degrees awarded and fifth in multi/interdisciplinary degrees. Additionally, the rankings placed the university in the top 50 institutions graduating the most Hispanic students in all three levels of degrees

overall – 27th in bachelor's degrees awarded; 37th in overall master's degrees; and 41st in doctoral degrees.

The bigheartedness of students, faculty and staff at Texas A&M-Kingsville lead to the university's inclusion in the first-ever President's Higher Education Community Service Honor Roll by the Corporation for National and Community Service in November. The Javelinas joined 15 other colleges and universities in the state that also were chosen for the honor. The application, prepared and submitted by Dr. Pam Doughty, assistant professor of health and kinesiology, found that 760 A&M-Kingsville students participated in community service between July 1, 2005 and June 30, 2006. More than two-thirds of those contributed more than 20 hours per semester. Of those who helped, 250 volunteered in projects related to hurricane relief combining for about 5,500 hours of work.

Distinguished Awards

Javelina Alumni Honor Distinguished Alumni and Faculty

The Javelina Alumni Association honored three faculty members and three alumni for their service and accomplishments in 2006.

The 2006 Distinguished Teacher Award was presented jointly to Dr. Daniel Suson and Dr. Randall Williams and the Distinguished Researcher Award to Dr. Susan Roberson. Suson is professor of physics and chair of the physics/geosciences department. In 2006, Suson's innovative College Physics I and II courses won national acclaim from the College Board. However, perhaps the best endorsement for this award came from one of his students, who said she was "clueless on the concept of physics" when she entered his class ... but because he takes time to help, she learned the material and was anticipating a high grade by the end of the semester.

Williams, professor of agronomy and resource sciences, is noted for providing leadership guidance to both undergraduates and graduate students. His dedication to students also goes beyond their commencement. Williams mentors his students after they leave A&M-Kingsville, continuing to monitor their progress and providing valuable advice to them as they pursue their careers.

Roberson is chair and assistant professor of language and literature. She studies the role that location plays in literature, particularly women's literature, looking at the location of literary characters and settings for their meaning and significance. Roberson has demonstrated success at winning research funding from the National Endowment for the Humanities, and her research road is one not widely traveled, making her work all the more important for its unique contribution to the body of knowledge.

Farias is the chairman of the board of Farias & Farias Inc., an international trading company in Laredo that provides customs clearance, freight forwarding, warehousing and distribution. He is well known in the international trade community having served several terms as president of the Laredo United States Customhouse Brokers Association and is currently president of the Texas Mexico Border International Trade Association. Farias earned a bachelor's degree in English and a master's degree in education, speech from Texas A&I University. He also earned a doctoral degree in medical education from Northwestern University.

Klett retired three years ago after serving 39 as a Texas band director and music coordinator, all but one of those years at Georgetown High School. Under his direction, the Georgetown band received 36 sweepstakes awards, won the state marching

His band was named outstanding at numerous national music festivals throughout Texas, Louisiana, Tennessee, Florida and Colorado. The marching and concert bands performed at the National Bandmasters Association's National Convention, the only time two bands from the same school have been asked to perform. Klett earned his bachelor's degree in music from Texas A&I University and his master's degree in education from Southwest Texas State University.

Martinez is the one of the most high profile alumnae of A&M-Kingsville in the Rio Grande Valley. She is currently morning and noon news anchor for KGBT-TV in Harlingen. She has been chosen Best TV Personality by in the Valley Morning Star's Reader's Choice Awards four of the last six years and A&M-Kingsville's communication and theatre arts department named her Alumna of the Year in 2003. She earned her bachelor's degree in communications with a minor in government and was chosen Miss TAMUK in 1998. Martinez followed in the footsteps of her father, who graduated from Texas A&I and her two older sisters, who received degrees from A&M-Kingsville.

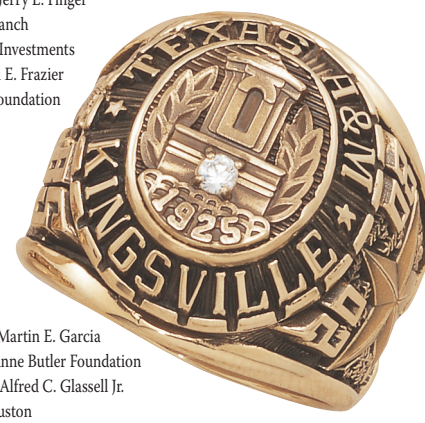

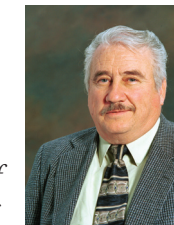

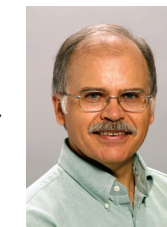
